

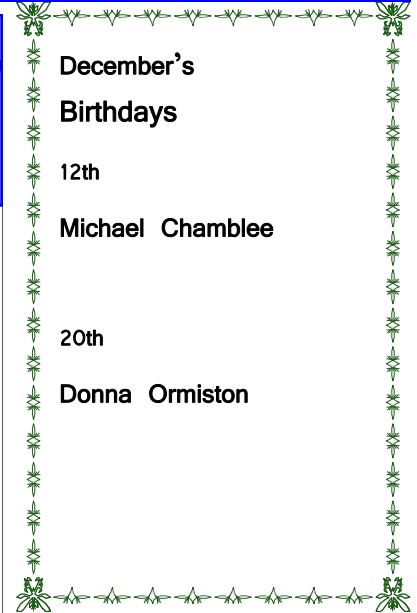
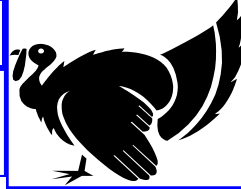

Gazebo Christmas decorations were strung . Snacks of cookies and coffee were provided for helpers.

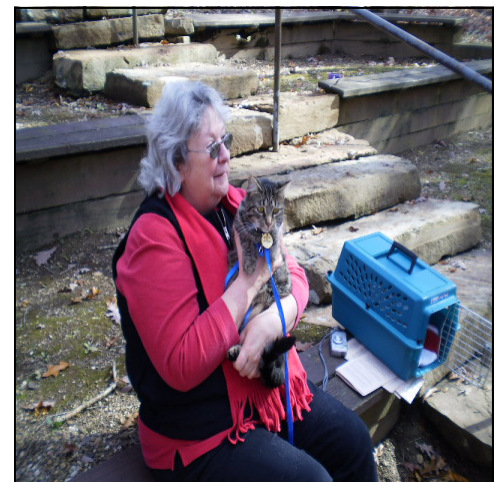
December 10th will be the Christmas Party at Judy & James Reichert's house which will benefit the Humane Society
